A Finance major can earn either a Bachelor of Business Administration (*BBA*) or a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (*BSBA*). Majors are required to take 21 credits, 18 of which must be in the Finance Department and beyond the required FIN 302. Students must earn a grade of "B" or better in FIN 302, and have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher after having completed FIN 302.

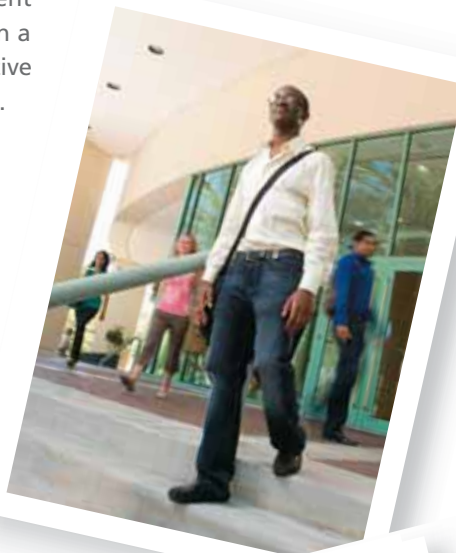
