A Management major can earn either a Bachelor of Business Administration (*BBA*) or a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (*BSBA*). Majors are required to take at least 21 credits but not more than 27 credits in the Management Department. All major/minor courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. Students must maintain an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
