

# GMAT - Graduate Management Admissions Test

## School of Business students need to be prepared in order to score well on the GMAT!

School of Business students should plan to take the GMAT in their senior year. The score is usually valid for up to 5 years. Therefore, if you plan to go to graduate school in the next couple of years, plan to take the GMAT while your test taking skills are sharp. Study for at least several months before taking the GMAT!

### GMAT Tutorial Workshops

- **Workshops will begin periodically throughout the year and run four weeks for each session.**
- Highly qualified faculty/instructors work with students in small groups or individually to improve their knowledge of the verbal and quantitative portions of the test.

**Note:** Take the sample GMAT test on-line (see below); if you score below a 600 then a tutorial workshop is highly recommended. Usually a score of 600 - 650 or higher is needed to be considered for admission and 650 or higher for a scholarship or graduate assistantship at most schools.

### Free Sample GMAT Tests

Free sample GMAT tests - Take sample test 1 & 2 twice

- 1) Go to [www.MBA.com](http://www.MBA.com) to take the free sample tests from your home computer; for computer assistance call 1-800-717-4628.
- 2) 1<sup>st</sup> time user's click on the "Sign Up" link in the box at the bottom of the home page  
 OR once you have registered go to "Log In & Password"
- 3) Go to top of the page and click on "Take the GMAT"
- 4) Scroll down to "Tools to help you prepare" - "GMAT Prep Products" - click on "Free GMAT Prep Test Preparation Software"
- 5) Click on Free Download, on left margin. Choose save file when prompted.
- 6) Read the step by step instructions on how to install and use GMAT Prep.
- 7) Once downloaded click on "Practice Content" then practice tests. There are two sample GMAT timed tests you can take. Test results will show immediately at the test's end. Finally, confer with Dr. Lewis.
